Headline: How They Used Ontario Commercialization Programs To Build A

Company

Brief:

Every year Ontario Centre's of Excellence (OCE) holds the Discovery conference that brings together leaders, investors, researchers and entrepreneurs to talk about emerging trends in advanced health, clean technology, digital media, manufacturing and the green economy. This year at Discovery, Quantum Dental Technologies (QDT) will discuss how they were successfully able to use Ontario commercialization programs to build their company.

News:

Going to market this fall, QDT is a model alumnus of a number of Ontario commercialization programs. As a successful spin off that originated from the Mechanical Engineering Department at the University of Toronto, QDT has gone from conception all the way through to R&D, clinical development, prototype development, as well as having navigated the regulatory hurdles in Canada,



the United States and the European Union.

QDT has sought advisory services on positioning and branding from MaRS; product development through OCE's and HTX's joint Business Investment Program; equity in exchange for development from INO (Institut national d'optique), and more...

Their product, The Canary System, detects tooth decay and offers prevention before fillings are required.

Now in their second round of financing, they are raising \$1.6 million to go towards the launch of their product and educating dentists about remineralization programs that prevent tooth decay and how this system can be easily integrated within their clinics.
